



# Selective Nerve Root Block (SNRB) in the Lumbar Spine







#### Overview

This injection targets a painful nerve in your lumbar spine. It helps your doctor find which nerve is hurt by a herniated disc, spinal stenosis or some other problem. It may give you pain relief.

## Preparation

To begin, you lie down. You may be given medicine to help you relax. The injection site is numbed.

## Placing the needle

Next, a needle is inserted through this numbed area. The doctor uses a fluoroscope (a video x-ray device) to guide the needle to the space around your inflamed nerve. The doctor may inject contrast dye to make sure the needle is in the right place.

#### Injection

Finally, the doctor injects the medicine. It bathes the target nerve. If your nerve is inflamed, it can relieve the pain and swelling.

## End of procedure

After your injection, you'll be watched for a short time, then you can go home. You may need to come back to have another procedure to relieve your pain. Your doctor will create a plan that's right for you.
